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November Release

The November release is scheduled for November 7, with changes to the client-server and J2EE modules. A new eRA password policy will be implemented that sets new rules for password aging and composition of the password itself. Each person will receive a message when their password must be changed. The message will include instructions and provides a grace period of ten logins before the account is closed. Analyst Change

The integration contract was awarded to IBM. The IBM liaison should be assigning an analyst to Committee Management soon. The structure will be slightly changed in that there will be an NIH task manager, someone from Sherry Zucker's group, and an IBM analyst.

Krishna will continue to attend CMUG meetings out of his own interest to be sure that the vision and redesign goals are not lost during the transition. However, this was his last "official" meeting as analyst.

New Business System

Gelco is operational now and the data bridges to the eRA System by the voucher number. The voucher number issued by the eRA System must be manually entered into the Gelco system in the "description/purpose" field. The first eight digits in this field must be the voucher number.

eRA System News

Dr. John J. McGowan (JJ), project manager for the eRA System, will leave the project at the end of December. JJ has been with the project for three years and in that time has accomplished his goals of increasing the funding so that the system can be successfully implemented and moving the project to a trans-HHS level. While he managed the eRA project, he continued his job at the NIAID. His replacement will probably be a full-time, dedicated manager for the eRA System project.

With the change in contractor structure, Jim Cain, operations manager, has changed the way releases are done. Instead of setting a date with everyone scrambling to release as much as they can by that date, he has asked that project needs and scope be the drivers behind releases. He would like to take a more proactive stance.

Miscellaneous

Residential addresses—CM has been pulling data for residential addresses from the Training Activities module and the Payback module. When there was a conflict in addresses, the last university address was used as the residential address, thereby deleting the most-recent address. A workaround for this is to enter the most-recent address as the second address and then mark it as preferred.

Duplicate profiles—There still are many problems with duplicate profiles. The eRA System team is investigating possible electronic ways to collapse duplicate profiles.

New Analyst Orientation—The group agreed that the new analyst should be taken to Building 31, get acquainted with FRNs, vouchers, and the Peer Review/Internet Assisted Review, Grants Management, Receipt and Referral modules besides the Committee Management module. The analyst needs to know not just how the module works but how the NIH works.
