eResearch Portal is an enterprise software package which is configurable to the exact needs of each institution. eResearch Portal is designed to use XML from the ground up and will allow grants management staff and researchers to monitor the status of electronic Grants.gov submissions. It is completely web based and supports all modern web browsers and platforms. eResearch Portal's extensive profile system is designed to integrate easily with other medical systems and single sign-on solutions. The integrated and flexible architecture speeds proposal development by removing duplicate data entry and pre-population of information such as bio-sketch documents, previous research summaries, human and animal research information from the IRB or IACUC modules, and other institutional and organizational routing information. eResearch Portal allows researchers and grants management personnel at each institution to collaborate on proposals to produce the highest quality grant applications. Even researchers or contractors outside the institution can participate in the proposal development process.

eResearch Portal also offers:

- A flexible extranet security mechanism allowing content to be secured via role, organization, IP Address, or individual user account.
- A user friendly reporting system able to query any field on a grant or research

proposal. Reports can then be published to specific audiences or exported to Excel format.

- Fully configurable workflow system capable of routing applications through multi-step review cycles in serial or parallel.
- Digital signatures and complete proposal audit and change logs capable of tracking field level changes over time. The audio log always shows who did what and when.
