


## The grants.gov Project Teams



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## Single System Solution

- Trusted Broker Embodies Standards, Benefits Applicants and Agencies:
  - Sub Builds applicant knowledge of "core" data
  - Helps identify commonalities among agency-specific data




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# System Architecture

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
## *PureEdge - Downloadable Electronic Forms*

- PureEdge™ electronic forms support off-line application preparation
    - SF424 Plus Attachments
      - Forms can be arranged as downloadable packages
      - Package can identify mandatory, optional and “conditionally mandatory” forms
    - Provides for extensive data edit and validation at the user’s desktop
      - Mandatory, optional, and conditionally mandatory fields
      - Field format (e.g., telephone number, ZIP and ZIP+4, SSN/EIN)
    - Supports automated propagation of data among forms
- Work in progress is stored and managed on submitter’s machine

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## *Apply Pilot Scope*

- Timeframe: June 30-August 15
- Two Software Releases:
  - Version 1
    - Ability to Download and Submit Applications for Programs with Core Data
    - Agency Profile and Roles
    - Integration with CCR, E-Auth, and CFDA
    - Agency Integration – ZIP File with PDF & Attachments



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## *Apply Pilot Scope (Cont.)*

- Version 2
  - All of the Above plus Programs with Non-Core
  - Integration with FedGrants (Find module)
  - Agency Integration – XML File with System-to-System Interface (Web Services)
  - Applicant System-to-System Interface



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## *Criteria for Success*

- Pilot 80% of October Functional Requirements
- Pilot at Least One Non-Core Program
- Minimum of 15 Agencies Participate
- Minimum of 45 Applications Received
- Pilot Available on June 30<sup>th</sup>



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## *Getting Ready*

- May 30<sup>th</sup> – Agency Letter Soliciting Participation
- June 2<sup>nd</sup> – Outreach to Applicants Begins
- June 16<sup>th</sup> – Due Date for Agency Sign-Up & Identification of Program
- End of June
  - User Guide
  - FAQs Available
  - Agency Set-up in Grants.Gov



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## *Timelines*

- June 30<sup>th</sup> – Pilot Begins, Version 1 Release
- Mid-July – Begin Evaluation of Pilot
- July 30<sup>th</sup> – Version 2 Release
- August 15<sup>th</sup> – Pilot Ends
- End of August – Lessons Learned Document
