

Commons to IMPACII Logon Trend



Facts

- Over 2,000 Grantee Institutions Registered in the Commons
 - 95% of all awarded applications (2002-2004)
- ❖50,000 Grantees Registered with Account
 - 66% of PIs receiving an award have a Commons Account (55% of ALL PIs)
- ❖720 JITs Submitted in 2004 (15%)
- ❖3700 eSNAPs Submitted (13%)
- Closeout in Commons February 2005



Systemic Issues

- Conservative 10% Estimated Error Rate on Commons Transactions such as eSnap, JIT, and soon Closeout (Fixes require Paper Process).
- Internal Staff seeing Different View of Data than External Grantees (3 day delay in display of Award, Summary Statement, Scores)
- Program Official/Grants Specialist /SRA Require Same View as Grantee
- HHS OpDivs into Commons Difficult until Full Work-Flow deployed
- Workflow does not end at SO Submission to NIH (it begins there)

2004 Priority

- Delivered Closeout/Content Management (February 2005)
- Designed/Began Development of Org Hierarchies
- Developed eNotification engine
- HHS OPDIVs into eRA (not Commons)
- Contracts (September 2005)
- Identified Workflow Architecture
- Developed Integrated Approach for 2005 and beyond called "One-View"



One-View

- One View is an integrated approach to initiate and process all eRA transactions electronically. It consists of three primary parts:
 - Single Login for all eRA applications Including Commons
 - Single method for notification of actions/events
 - Single interface to initiate and process a request, regardless of context (within HHS and Grantee Community)



One-View 2005 Objectives

- Single login for eRA (External and Internal)
- Single login includes eNotification events
 - Email
 - UI Display of Event (Acknowledge/Process)
 - Web Service Through Exchange (Really 2006)
- Historical record of notification events
- Consolidated storage of all requests/transactions into the Grant Folder ("Other Relevant Documents")
 - Updated UI
 - Project View instead of Grant View
 - Hierarchy Rights for Permissions to View
 - Include all appropriate Documents
- Standard method for requests and transactions (Internal/External)

- May/June 2005 eNotifications for Public Access and Status (IC Assigned, Council Assigned, etc.)
- ❖October 2005 Organizational Hierarchy (RIGHTS) in Commons
- ❖December 2005 Modified Transactions (One-View)



One-View 2006 Goals (Affecting External Community)

- Declaration that all requests be done online/electronically
- HHS OPDIVs fully integrated into Commons
- ❖ Redo Delegation!!!
- Expand Org Hierarchies/Flexible Permissions in GM/901 and then eRA.
- Include One View for xTrain through to HHS
- Increase the number of electronic requests supporting all of eRA and fully automate existing ones.
