#### **CURRENT/LONGSTANDING POLICY**

- Only one version of a grant application can be active
- IMPAC Modules ensure:
  - When A1 (or A2) assigned in referral, previous version withdrawn
    - "Application withdrawn for amendment"
  - When an earlier version is awarded, subsequent version is withdrawn

"Application withdrawn, previous version awarded"

#### **CHANGES IN PRACTICE**

An A1 or A2 application may be submitted before previous version is considered by council:

- Expedited review for fellowships, small business, AIDS applications, pilots
- Earlier review meetings/faster Summary Statement Production in general

#### **PROBLEM CREATED**

- Previous version would not get council consideration that is legally required for award.
- ICs need to use a "manual" process to assure council consideration of earlier version and potential award opportunity.

# **MAA - SOLUTION**

- Multiple Active Applications
- Keep all versions (01, A1, A2 for example) of application active
- If any version awarded, other versions will be withdrawn
- Applications never awarded withdrawn according to schedule set in Manual Chapter (54502)
- IMPAC will flag applications if A1 and/or A2 submitted

# **eRA IMPLEMENTATION**

- To begin in February 2008
- Has implications for many business areas
- Overall
  - Display MAA flag when other active versions exist
  - Link to list of all other versions
- Grant folder MAA flag whenever other active versions exist

#### eRA Implementation (continued)

#### Referral

- When A1 or A2 is assigned in the Division of Receipt and Referral, previous version will not be withdrawn.
- Applications that are part of a MAA cluster will be identified
- Cluster will be maintained when resubmission assigned to a different IC.

#### eRA Implementation (continued)

- Review will be a flag to identify MAA application
- Program
  - O Applications in MAA cluster flagged
  - Search Capabilities
- Grants Management
  - When start "Work in Progress" display alert that other versions exist
  - When a MAA application is awarded, all other version withdrawn
  - Status message: "Withdrawn by IC, previous record encumbered"
