## **One-View**

One View is an integrated approach to initiate and process all eRA transactions electronically. It consists of three primary parts:

- Single login for all eRA applications including Commons
- Single method for notification of actions/events (i.e., eNotification)
- Single interface to initiate and process a request, regardless of context (within HHS and grantee community)



## Why One-View

- PI/SO/Program Official/Grants Specialist/SRA require same view
- HHS OPDIVs into Commons difficult until workflow deployed
- Workflow does not end at SO submission to HHS (it begins there)
- Estimated 10% error rate on externally initiated transactions such as eSNAP, JIT, and soon Closeout (fixes require paper process)
- GM/Program/CGAP/TA/e901/Commons require:
  - One login to eRA
  - Approval chains spanning multiple existing modules

## **One-View 2005 Objectives**

- Single login includes eNotification events
  - Email
  - UI display of event (Acknowledge/Process)
- Historical record of notification events
- Standard method for requests and transactions (internal/external)

## **Features**

- Decline capability
- Recall capability
- Content specific to Request and Status
- Post-Process transactions (i.e., Type 7
  "Shell") expect faster turnaround
- Checklist/relinquishing/face page UIs are to be developed for data capture
- Requests available for searching Reporting, Tracking, Analysis
