

## eRA Commons Accounts: Who and How and Where

Who needs an account?	How do they get an account?	Where can information be found?
<b>Institutions/Research Organizations</b>	Institutions and organizations register with eRA Commons, and at the time of registration, they assign a Signing Official (SO) and an Account Administrator (AA). These people can create additional accounts after the registration process is complete. <b>Program Directors/Principal Investigators (PD/PI)</b>	If a PD/PI has never had an eRA Commons account, an SO or an AA can create an account for them. <b>Trainees</b>	Trainees are invited to register in eRA Commons by the supervising Principal Investigator. Or an SO or AA can create the account for the trainee. <b>NIH Scholars</b>	NIH Scholars can create an account in eRA Commons by registering themselves as an institution. So they must complete all the same steps and registrations as an institution/research organization. <b>Scientist Post-Doc Graduate Students Undergraduate Students Project Personnel</b>	These classifications or roles have no functional abilities within eRA Commons. They are used for reporting purposes in relation to the Biomedical Research Workforce initiative. Accounts for these users are created by an SO or AA.
