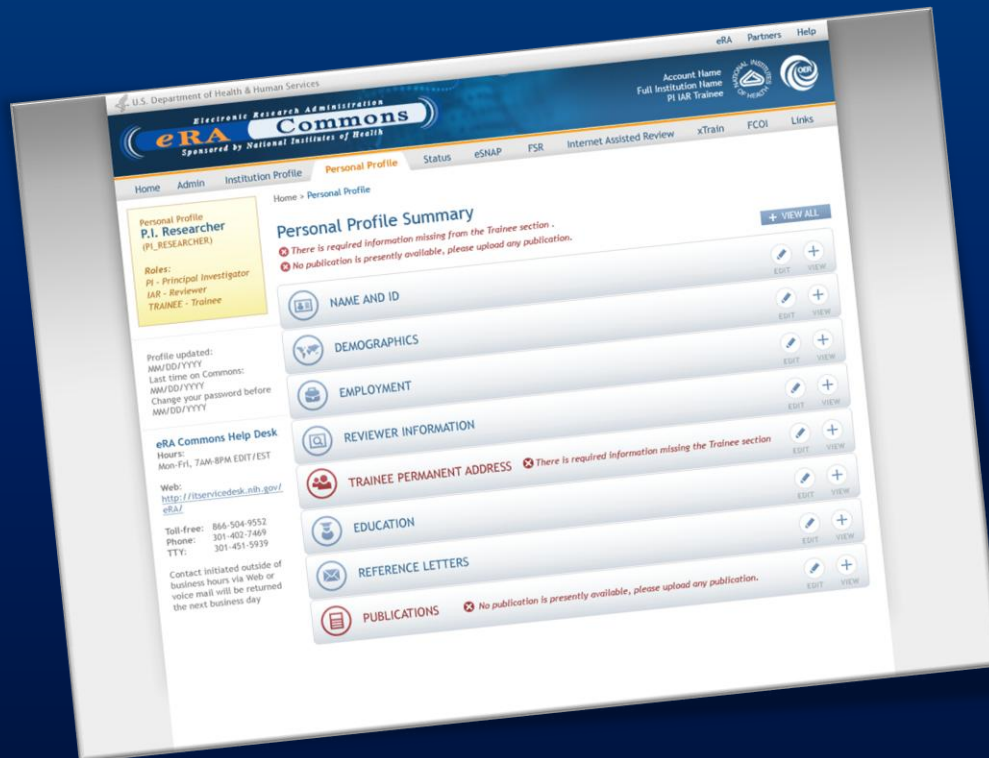

If you participate in at least 6 qualifying meetings in an 18 month period, you are eligible for continuous submission for the following government fiscal year.
